North Newton School Corporation Frequently Asked Questions ELearning

The North Newton School Corporation utilizes approved ELearning days authorized by the Indiana Department of Education for a variety of purposes-inclement weather cancellations, professional development, parent teacher conferences, widespread illness and flooding.

Why Have ELearning?

NNSC recognizes classroom instruction as the most valuable learning environment. IN situations where inclement weather forces school cancellation, ELearning is the next best instructional learning environment. ELearning days provide instruction and reinforcement allowing for progress to continue in an inclement weather situation or other event.

When this happens, instruction is not interrupted, learning continues and the days do not have to be made up.

ELearning is everywhere: We see technology in most workplaces, in more and more K-12 school settings and in all universities. NNSC students need opportunities to experience and become comfortable with this type of learning.

What Does This Look Like For Students?

Students will use iPads and/or Chromebooks to complete content that has been assigned to them, just as if school were in session. Student who need extra help or have questions can contact their teacher(s) through email or through electronic formats such as Google Classroom, Class Dojo, etc.

Attendance

ELearning instruction will begin at 9:00am. Students with Internet access will sign into their Google Classroom or will contact their teacher. Students without Internet access must call the school office to report attendance or leave a message with the school.

Amount of Work Time Required of Students?

Students will be required to complete lesson assigned to them by their teachers. It is expected that lessons are completed ON the day of ELearning. Students should have 4-6 hours of work during the day, based on grade level of the student.

When Is Work Due?

We ask that all students complete all assigned work during ELearning. Teachers are available from 9:00am-5:00pm on each ELearning day. Students without access to the Internet will be expected to complete their work within 2 regular school days. Work turned in after 2 completed school days is subject to the late policies of each individual school's policy regarding late work.

Can I Complete Work During the School Day Once We Return to School?

If you are without Internet access and use the school's connection to complete your assignments once school is in session, the assignments must be completed prior to or after school. They may not be completed during a scheduled class day. Contact the classroom teacher regarding makeup options to complete assignments.

Teacher Availability

Teachers will be online and available via email from 9:00am-5:00pm. Teachers may use resources to conduct online discussions with students using a variety of educational services tailored to the particular objectives being taught for the lesson.
